This small fund is designed to provide immediate financial assistance to whānau and individuals who need support for schooling, recreational activities, or cultural participation. The fund aims to help ease financial barriers, ensuring that people can access important opportunities that contribute to their personal growth and well-being. Each application will be considered carefully, and funds will be allocated based on need and availability. The maximum amount that can be requested from this fund is \$200 per application.

To be eligible for the Community Grants Scheme, the following criteria applies:

- Applicants must live in the Coromandel-Colville ward
- Applicants must demonstrate the need for the specific request
